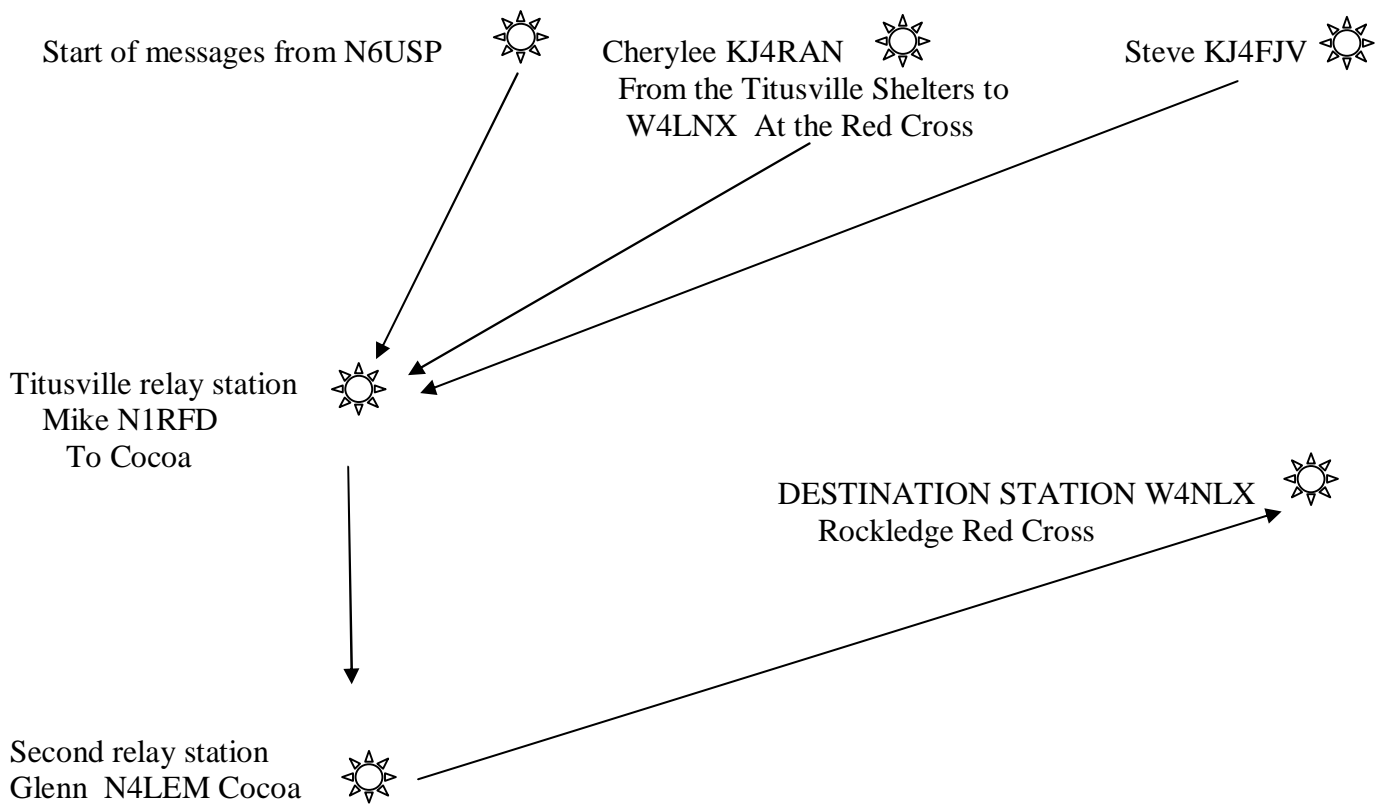


How to send traffic (messages) via relay when in simplex mode.



Titusville EmComm operators can not work Cocoa using Simplex without using relays.

When we go simplex, Glenn is going to be our relay at Ray's N4LEM EOC Backup station for the SET. He will relay all traffic to the EOC and the Red Cross. Mike N1RFD is our Titusville operator for relays.

This message is for the Red Cross.

You will but the callsign that the message is intended to go to (W4NLX) at the Red Cross in the Destination Callsign box and fill out your message.

Do not click the send button for traffic that must go by relays. Instead click the Send via button, now a [Enter destination window will open],, click the down arrow and click on the callsign of the first relay station that you want the message (N1RFD) who is the relay operator for Titusville to send the message to Glenn.

The receiving person (Glenn) will now forward it to the destination callsign (Del AK4EY Red Cross operator) Now the message reply must follow the same route in reverse to get back to the sending station.
